Valentine's Day

Students may bring Valentine cards to distribute to their classmates if they wish. We ask that those bringing Valentine's, bring one for each student in the class (please see the attached list for student's names). Valentines provide an excellent opportunity for the children to see that writing has a purpose and provides them an opportunity to practice their printing.

Here are some suggestions regarding Valentines:

- When purchasing Valentine's cards, choose cards that have a large space to print who it is to and from.
- Have your child start addressing cards early. Printing a few cards each day results in a better experience for everyone involved - and better printing too!
- Please do not use all capital letters when addressing the Valentine cards, as the students will be matching names to how they are printed below.
- Include both names on each card, who the card is 'To' and who it is 'From'. In previous years, some children haven't written the name of the child the card is to, figuring that this would make passing out easier. This does not tend to work as the children forget who they have passed to, and who they have not.
- If you are including anything (such as chocolates, pencils or stickers) with the Valentine card, <u>please tape</u> it securely to the card or put it in little baggies as these things tend to become easily dislodged.
